3. Approval of the minutes from the May 12, 2022 meeting. Dr. Scalzitti moved to approve as drafted, C. Hadley seconded. All aye. Motion carried.
4. Medical Advisor Report – Covid19 new bivalent Omicron booster available at pharmacies. Ascension and Health dept. do not have yet. Flu shots available at pharmacies. Monkey pox vaccine available. Doctors encouraging childhood vaccines, catch up needs to be done since covid.
5. Public Health Administrator Report
 - a. Coronavirus (COVID-19) update: Disease Investigation, Testing, Vaccination
 - high community transmission in Milwaukee County
 - flat line higher level in SM/SF communities
 - Pfizer and Moderna bivalent boosters to be offered when available, clinics scheduled in OC, CU, SM, and SF
 - Clinics will offer flu, covid19, and tdap
 - At least 2 months from primary or other doses for booster
 - Johnson and Johnson vaccine no longer available
 - Novavax vaccine offered at CU and Milw, but few taking
 - Testing - Health dept. still doing PCR. State is shifting to antigen tests to send home with people or state will send to people through SayYesCovidHomeTest.org.

 - c. Department Staffing Updates – Jaclyn Morales, new Health Sanitarian, passed her Registered Sanitarian exam. Samantha Osmann, new Public Health Specialist, comes as a certified Health Education Specialist. Taylor Wey, PHN, is now a certified lactation consultant. Breastfeeding locations are being founded in SM city hall, Zion school, and SF schools.
6. 2023 Proposed Budget - breaks down to 60% tax levy and 40% grant funds. Budget for 2023 was decreased by 5% in tax levy. V. Dominski moved to accept budget as proposed, C. Hadley seconded. All aye. Motion carried.
