

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS
OF THE COMMON COUNCIL
Regular Meeting

South Milwaukee
March 1, 2022

The Regular Meeting of the Common Council was called to order by Acting Mayor Bartoshevich at 7:00 p.m. On roll, all were present except Maass and Clark who were excused.

The meeting was prefaced by the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no deletions to the agenda.

Under President of the Council, Bartoshevich/Pieper moved to adopt the items in the consent agenda: a) approval of minutes from the February 15, 2022 Common Council meeting; and b) approval of Charles Olszewski and Noah Witting to the Water/Wastewater Commission and Michael Stritchko and Carla Uphill as Alternate Members of the Board of Review. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Finance, Bukowski/Pieper moved to adopt Resolution No. 22-08 authorizing the transfer of funds to close out completed capital equipment purchases and allocate remaining funds. On roll call, all voted aye. Motion carried.

Under Human Resources Committee, Navarro/Backes moved to grant Economic Development Project Manager Ericka Lang three weeks of vacation upon her start date and in subsequent years. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Legislation & Permits Committee, Briesemeister/Backes moved for Suspension of Rule 2.11 A(2) to allow the proposed ordinance to repeal and replace Chapter 7 of the Municipal Code pertaining to the Fire Department be given its first, second and third reading at this meeting. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried. Briesemeister/Backers moved to give Ordinance No. 2225 to repeal and replace Chapter 7 of the Municipal Code pertaining to the Fire Department its first, second and third reading, adopt the ordinance and publish a summary in the official newspaper as required by law. All voted aye, motion carried.

Briesemeister/Backes moved for Suspension of Rule 2.11 A(2) to allow the proposed ordinance to repeal and replace Chapter 27 of the Municipal Code pertaining to Fire Prevention, Protection and Control be given its first, second and third reading at this meeting. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried. Briesemeister/Backers moved to give Ordinance No. 2226 to repeal and replace Chapter 27 of the Municipal Code pertaining to Fire Prevention, Protection and Control be given its first, second and third reading, adopt the ordinance and publish a summary in the official newspaper as required by law. All voted aye, motion carried.


Briesemeister/Backes moved for Suspension of Rule 2.11 A(2) to allow the proposed ordinance to amend Chapter 18 of the Municipal Code pertaining to the Plumbing Code be given its first, second and third reading at this meeting. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried. Briesemeister/Backers moved to give Ordinance No. 2227 to amend Chapter 18 of the Municipal Code pertaining to the Plumbing Code be given its first, second and third reading, adopt the ordinance and publish a summary in the official newspaper as required by law. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Plan Commission, Briesemeister/Backes moved to approved Resolution No. 22-09 to approve the Certified Survey Map to re-divide lands at 906 and 914 Columbia Avenue to create 2 lots. All voted aye, motion carried.

Briesemeister/Backes moved to approved the conditional use permit to amend the mixed commercial-residential use at 1013 Milwaukee Avenue, zoned C-3 Central Business to include tattooing as part of the personal services use. All voted aye, motion carried.

Briesemeister/Backer moved to schedule a public hearing on the Plan Commission's recommendation to amend zoning code to create a Planned Development District for a portion of the property at 1100 Milwaukee Avenue3 for repurposing of certain buildings for 160 residential units and commercial use together with various site improvements for April 19, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. All voted aye, motion carried.

There being no further business to discuss, Backes/Bartoshevich moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:15 p.m. All voted aye, motion carried.
