The Special Meeting of the Common Council was called to order by Acting Mayor Bartoshevich at 6:00 p.m. On roll, all were present except Pieper who was excused.

The meeting was prefaced by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Maass/Briesemeister moved to authorize a contract for 3rd District Storm Sewer Improvements with Earth-X, LLC in a base contract of \$319,842.00 with funding from the Storm Water Utility. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried.

City Engineer Vandercar explained the upcoming asphalt repairs needed in the city. Maass/Briesemeister moved to authorize the City Engineer to advertise contract for various asphalt repairs. All voted aye, motion carried.

Bartoshevich/Clark moved to adopt Resolution No. 22-10 to authorize the City Engineer to apply for the Runoff Management Grant offered by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. All voted aye, motion carried.



Stats. 19.85(1)(e) and (g) for the purpose of conferring with legal counsel regarding strategy for labor negotiations with the South Milwaukee Professional Police Association and a potential claim by a former city employee. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried.
