Regular Meeting

September 6, 2022

The Regular Meeting of the Common Council was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Council President Bartoshevich. On roll, all were present except Mayor Shelenske and Alderperson Clark who were excused.

The meeting was prefaced by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Under President of the Council, Bartoshevich/Pieper moved to adopt the items in the consent agenda: a) approval of minutes from the August 16, 2022 Common Council meeting; b) approval of the Schedule of Vouchers for the period ending August 31, 2022 in the amount of \$4,384,440.67; c) approval of the financial reports for the various funds for the periods ending June 30, 2022 and July 31, 2022; and d) appointment of Lisa Mower, Cheryl Heiser and Sara Jordan to the Supplemental Pollworker list. Navarro/Backes moved to approve the position description for the Water/Wastewater Clerk. All voted aye, motion carried.


Navarro/Backes moved to approve the position description for the part-time Police Clerk. All vote aye, motion carried.

Under Legislation & Permits Committee, Pieper/Bukowski moved to approve Ordinance No. 2230 to amend Section 23.20(A) of the Municipal Code pertaining to vicious dogs and give it its second and third reading and publish a summary ordinance in the official newspaper as required by law. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Reports of the Mayor, Bartoshevich/Pieper moved to receive and place on file, the 2021 South Milwaukee Fire Department Annual Report. All voted aye, motion carried.

Bartoshevich/Pieper moved to adopt a Civic Resolution in recognition of Curt Witynski and Gail Sumi for their years of service to Wisconsin's local leaders through their roles with the League of Wisconsin Municipalities. All voted aye, motion carried.
